Sunday, October 6 | Departing for Memphis



At the end of the tour, make a stop at his grave and remember how wonderful his music was. Then your group will head to the restaurant where Elvis used to eat lunch, just across the street. After lunch depart for the legendary Sun Studios, a Memphis ICON! You can't come to Memphis and NOT stop here. You'll enjoy the 45 minute tour, hear the inside stories of B.B. King, Johnny Cash, Howlin' Wolf, Ike Turner, Elvis Presley, Carl Perkins and Roy Orbison. You will actually hear some of those first original recordings while standing right in the place where they were recorded. It's cool! Friday, October 11 | Heading Home

Depart your hotel this morning to begin heading home. Enjoy a stop in St. Louis to visit the Missouri Civil War Museum.
