Day 4 | From Galway to the Cliffs of Moher to Killarney

This morning after your included breakfast, depart from



Galway and make your way to the awe inspiring and majestic Cliffs of Moher, which rise 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. A spectacular day with great sea and cliff views! Continue on to Killarney where you will spend the next two nights. **Breakfast & Dinner Included**

Day 5 | The Dingle Peninsula

After breakfast, a delightful day takes you along the Kerry coast to the Dingle Peninsula, which offers magnificent coastal scenery. Beyond Sleah Head, view see the Blasket Islands, the last outpost of Europe. After full day tour, return back to Killarney where you enjoy dinner on your own this evening, perhaps at one of Killarney's famous "Singing Pubs"!

Day 6 | Traveling to Dublin with stops at Blarney Castle and Cashel

Blarney, travel via Tipperary and Cashel, where your group will pause for a photo-op at the historic Rock of Cashel. Arrive in Dublin, where the evening is free to dine on your own tonight. You will then check into your Castle Hotel in Killiney, Co. for the next two nights just outside of Dublin. Your castle hotel is situated at the brow of Killiney Hill, in the prestigious south Dublin suburb of Killiney and overlooking Dublin Bay.

Day 7 | Dublin

After your included breakfast, head into the capital city this morning for a full day of sightseeing. Visit the Guinness Storehouse, enjoying panoramic views of the city from the Gravity Bar, followed by the EPIC Museum just across from the Jeanie Johnston famine tall ship that brought immigrants safely to America. Then, enjoy some free time to explore the capital city independently and have a little lunch on your own. Dublin has plenty of shops, cafes, museums, and more for you to visit. This evening, there will be a farewell dinner at your castle hotel in Killiney, Co. Dublin. Celebrate the end of a fantastic tour, and then head to your room to pack for home.
