Join Jeanie's Journeys on this amazing visit of the Southwest to tour Canyonlands, Zion, Bryce, and Grand Canyon National Parks! In addition, enjoy a visit to Las Vegas!

Day 1 | Flying to Canyon Country

Meet your adventure guide at the MSP Airport. You will then depart on your nonstop flight into Las Vegas. Upon arrival, grab your luggage and head outside to meet your bus driver. You will then head north into Canyon Country! Arrive in St. George, Utah for the night where you will check into your hotel and then enjoy a great welcome dinner together with your group, looking forward to the awesome journey ahead of you!

Day 2 | Zion National Park

This morning after an included breakfast, Motor toward spectacular Zion National Park. In sheer magnitude and color, Zion is very likely one of the most awe-inspiring National Parks in the world. Enjoy a Tram ride through the Park and spend time looking up at the magnificent rock formations. A bit of time for a walk down one of the many trails will broaden your experience. Lunch will be enjoyed on your own at the Lodge restaurant before you continue your spectacular journey towards Bryce Canyon National Park. Your group will arrive at the Historic Ruby's Inn, which is just outside the entrance of the Park and spend the next two nights.

Day 3 | Bryce Canyon

Enjoy breakfast at the Inn before you embark on a day of touring spectacular Bryce Canyon National Park. Experience thousands of delicately carved spires as they rise in brilliant color from the amphitheaters of Bryce Canyon. Millions of years of wind, water and geologic mayhem have shaped and etched the cliffs at Bryce, which isn't actually a canyon but the eastern slope of the Paunsaguant Plateau. Motor along the rim road, where magnificent spires known as "hoodoos"



show colors of pink, orange, and red. You may see wildlife, including pronghorn, coyotes, marmots, and prairie dogs. Return to the Inn with your group for a restful evening on your own

Day 4 | Moab, Utah

Today after an included breakfast, depart for Moab, UT. Moab is just outside of Arches and Canyonlands National Parks. Your drive will take you through Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument via Scenic Byway 12, an All American Road. Traveling over the Hogback, your group will continue along the way toward Boulder Mountain in the Dixie National Forest and on towards Capital Reef National Park. This is one of the most spectacular roads in America. You will be awed by the amazing scenery around you! Enjoy dinner at the Red Cliffs Lodge on the banks of the Colorado River this evening after you check in with your group for the next two nights.

Day 5 | Arches & Canyonlands Nat'l Park

After breakfast you will tour Arches National Park which contains the world's largest concentration of natural



stone arches. This National Park is a red, arid desert, punctuated with oddly eroded sandstone forms such as fins, pinnacles, spires, balanced rocks, and arches truly "miracles of nature." Canyonlands National Park includes a huge area of rugged land west and south of Moab, Utah. It consists of canyons and plateaus carved by two mighty rivers – the Colorado and the Green. Later your group will return to the Lodge for a restful evening.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Box Lunch

Day 6 | Moab to Lake Powell

After checking out of your hotel, your first stop today will be at the Navajo Nation Visitor Center at Monument Valley. Here you will have a spectacular view of some of the iconic rock formations in the Valley. Experience uniquely shaped monoliths, buttes, and mesas of red sandstone from this great vantage point. Can you picture those cowboys on horseback riding across the screen in a John Wayne western? Enjoy a Navajo Taco lunch and then you will have time to visit the Trading Post before you group continues on towards Lake Powell. Stop at Glen Canyon Dam along the way and see how power is supplied to much of the area. You will then check into the Lake Powell Resort for a two night stay and enjoy a special dinner this evening in the Rainbow Room!

Day 7 | Lake Powell

After enjoying breakfast at the resort, your first adventure will be a walking tour of Antelope Canyon. Get an up-close opportunity to view the narrow, colorful, and sculpted geology as you walk through the sandstone walls of this slot canyon. Later climb aboard rafts for an afternoon float trip down the Colorado River through the awesome Glen Canyon with sandstone cliffs that rise a half mile above us. A day you will long remember before heading back to your hotel for a restful evening on your own.

The first glimpse of the Grand Canyon is always breathtaking with its stunning color and vastness. Your group will motor along the canyon rim taking time for photo stops. Later enjoy dinner on your own while you look for the sunset over the canyon.

Day 9 | Grand Canyon to Las Vegas

After checking out of your hotel, today your travels will take us over the new Hoover Dam bridge where you will have a fantastic view of this magnificent Dam and the river far below.
