

With Mackinac Island's Elegant Grand Hotel, Holland's Dutch Windmills, German Fun In Frankenmuth & Branson-style Entertainment at a Reindeer Farm!

### DAY 1 | HARDY'S REINDEER RANCH

Depart on your luxury motor coach for the ride north through Illinois to Rantoul, where you will check-in to your hotel for the evening. You will then head out to Hardy's Reindeer Ranch. Your visit will start with the Reindeer Experience Tour where your group will get up close and personal with the reindeer. You might even get a 'kiss'! Weather permitting, Mr. Hardy will take you on a tractor driven buggy ride through their diverse Midwest farm. Learn how Hardy's started with a small Christmas Tree Farm and two reindeer and grew into a major tourist attraction! Make sure to make enough time to visit Hardy's Country Barn Gift Shop which was hand built with wood salvaged from old barns in the area. It's heated by an old pot-belly stove and filled with ornaments, giftables and delicious treats. #### DAY 2 | HOLLAND, MICHIGAN!

The Grand Hotel was the setting of 1980's time travel romance film "Somewhere in Time" starring Christopher Reeve and Jane Seymour. At the Grand Hotel, you can participate in hotel activities such as bocce ball, bean bag toss, enjoy a garden tour, rent a bike or relax on the longest hotel porch in the world while taking in the views of Lake Huron. Evenings at the Grand Hotel require dressier attire for dinner in the evening, so press and polish your finest outfits for an included dressy dinner with the option of dancing afterwards to a live big band.

See the Holz-Brucke, a 19th century covered bridge and colorful gingerbread-like houses. Behold Frankenmuth's "Maibaum" or Maypole and listen to the festive 35-bell Glockenspiel Tower. It's delightful music is accompanied by Black Forest wooden figures acting out the Pied Piper of Hamelin legend. You will then check-in to your German Inspired hotel for the evening. After check-in, head to the kitchen to learn how to make German-style pretzels by rolling the dough. You will then have your creation baked for you to enjoy! Dinnertime is now here! You will then enjoy a fantastic family-style German chicken dinner, the chicken that put Frankenmuth on the map! After indulging in your "all you can eat" adventure, it's time to head down the hall to relax for the rest of the evening.
