### Day 1 | NORTHWARD TO DULUTH

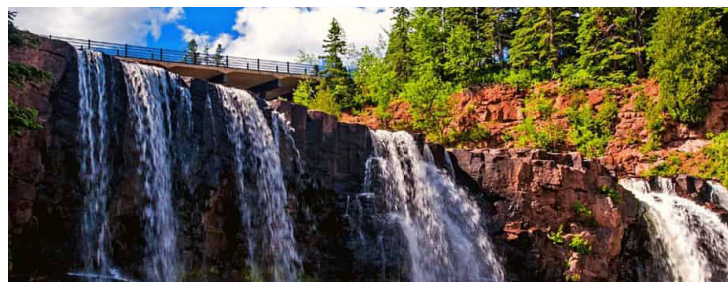

This evening, enjoy an included dinner at the revolving restaurant at the top of the hotel, one of the last revolving restaurants in the country. ### Day 2 | THE NORTH SHORE & LEAF PEEPING

After breakfast on your own, travel with the group along The North Shore to view Lake Superior at it's most wild. Enjoy a stop at Gooseberry Falls, where you can view the falls from a short or a longer walk to view it up close! Continue on to Split Rock Lighthouse. A November gale that wrecked nearly 30 ships in 1905 prompted this rugged landmark's construction. When the U.S. Lighthouse Service completed Split Rock Light Station in 1910, it soon became one of Minnesota's best known destinations. Nestled in a Minnesota State Park, Split Rock Lighthouse is one of the most photographed and visited spots in the state, with a drama-filled history and breathtaking Lake Superior views. Enjoy your visit here to a true North Shore icon. After your visit, continue on to Lutsen mountain where you will have your choice of lunch on your own at the base of the mountain or at the top! If you wish to have lunch on the top, you will take a complimentary ride on the gondola to the top of the



mountain with it's lovely views. After lunch, continue northward and check-in one of the northernmost lodges in Minnesota, the Grand Portage Lodge which sits on native land. This evening join your group in the Island View Restaurant for an included dinner. After dinner, relax and enjoy a walk along the lake, or if you feel lucky, walk just next door to the casino for some gambling action. Good Luck!

### Day 3 | GRAND PORTAGE & GRAND MARAIS

After a yummy included breakfast at your lodge, depart for Grand Portage National Monument. Travel into the past and discover the partnership between the Grand Portage Anishinaabe Native Americans and the North West Company during the North American fur trade. Experience the sights and smells of a bustling depot reconstructed in its historic location. After touring the fort, Head to Grand Marais to poke around some of the cute shops in town and enjoy lunch on your own. After lunch your group will then head up either the Caribou or Gunflint Trail to view the fall colors. You will then return with your group back to your resort to relax for a little bit along the shores of Lake Superior. This evening, depart the lodge for an included farewell dinner in the





historic Naniboujou Lodge dining room. Step into the quiet elegance of this historic lodge which has been operating for over 90 years and boasts the largest fireplace in all of Minnesota. Let the beauty of the lodge surround you as you enjoy dinner this evening. Then, head back with your group to Grand Portage Lodge for the rest of the evening free to do as you wish.
