DAY 4 | ELEGANT FLORENCE

After your included breakfast, you will be transferred by water taxi to Venice Tronchetto on land where you





will meet your coach and driver. You will then depart for Florence, one of the most famous cities of art and history in the world and the cradle of the Renaissance. Upon arrival, you will be met by your tour guide for a 4-hour walking trip through Florence with an included visit to see "David" at the Accademia Gallery. You will then depart for the charming town of Poggibonsi in Chianti to spend the night.

DAY 5 | ANCIENT ORVIETO

Your coach driver will pick you up for your drive to the hill town of Orvieto. Orvieto is a small city perched on a rock cliff with winding cobblestone streets and fine wines. The ancient church of Orvieto, dating from 1290, has a mosaic façade and houses a marble Pietà sculpture. An underground cave network attests to the city's preRoman Etruscan roots. Enjoy some free time to explore the history of this area and enjoy lunch on your own before continuing to Rome where you will check-in to your hotel for the next three nights. Enjoy this evening on your own.

DAY 6 | TOURING ROME

After an included breakfast, explore with your guide the "Eternal City" which stands as one of the finest and oldest cities in the world. The history of Rome spans over 2,500 years and it has been a center of power, politics, culture, and development since its inception. This city is steeped in legend and mythology as there are various stories of how this majestic metropolis was built. Several Roman emperors and Caesers have ruled mighty Rome. This is the city where the colossal Roman Empire grew. View the world-famous Colosseum and the Palatine Hill and Imperial Forums. The Vatican Museum with Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Basilica will fascinate you. The Vatican Museums are the public museums of Vatican City, enclave of Rome. They display works from the immense collection amassed by the Catholic Church and the papacy throughout the centuries, including several of the most well-known Roman sculptures and most important masterpieces of Renaissance art in the world. **BREAKFAST**

After an included breakfast, head out to enjoy the city on your own. Walk, call a cab, or use your Uber app to travel to where you want and to see what you want. Maybe visit the Pantheon or tour the inside of the Colosseum. Perhaps visit the Spanish Steps or throw three coins in the Trevi Fountain. Don't forget to enjoy lunch at a local restaurant while watching the world go by and then do a little shopping. After your day, return back to the hotel to enjoy an included farewell dinner together. Then it's time to pack for your trip home before enjoying one last sleep in Italy.
