Day 1 | Depart for Canada

Depart with Debbie for the Nashville, BNA International Airport. You will then depart in the afternoon for Vancouver, British Columbia Canada (**PASSPORT REQUIRED**). Upon landing, pick up your luggage and head out the door to your waiting motor-coach where you will be whisked away to your hotel for the night. Day 2 | Cruising Begins

After an included breakfast, depart your hotel for a tour of Vancouver with a local guide. Visit Stanley Park, Prospect Point Lookout, Dr. Sun Yat Sen Garden & much more. You will then arrive at Canada Place Cruise Port. Proceed through check-in at the terminal. Then board your cruise ship that will be your home for the next eight days. Welcome to the Caribbean Princess! Enjoy lunch on the ship at either the buffet or main dining room & then have some time to explore this magnificent ship! DAY 3 | Cruising!

Today is sea day! There is nothing more relaxing than sitting on a deck chair with a cozy blanket as the ship sails along. Take in all the amenities that the ship has to offer. DAY 4 | Ketchikan, Alaska

Ketchikan is The Salmon Capital of Alaska, a hub for sports fishing & home to a collection of wonderful totem poles. Enjoy poking around this historic city & viewing the cozy houses that hang over the river that runs through the town. Visit the Ranger Station in the middle of town for an overview of the history of the area. Don't forget to visit The Red Dog Saloon where you can swagger in through swinging double doors & say "Howdy Partner" to the saloon ladies.

DAY 5 | Juneau, Alaska

Surrounded by fjords, forest & snow-capped mountains, Juneau is one gorgeous state capital. Its historic downtown harkens back to its gold-rush origins & you can still pan for gold. But nature is the priceless treasure. When you're in Juneau, you shouldn't miss the amazing glacial landscape as the Mendenhall



Glacier is only 5 miles outside of town.

Shore Excursion Tips: Take a bus-Uber-cab to Mendenhall Glacier/Tram to the top of Mt. Roberts to see the magnificent view

DAY 6 | Skagway, Alaska

Skagway, Alaska is the northernmost point in Alaska's Inside Passage. In its heyday, Skagway was the boomtown gateway to the Trail of '98 & the Klondike gold fields. Home to the White Pass & Yukon Railroad, the "Scenic Railway of the World," it is one of Alaska's most popular visitor attractions & should not be missed. This narrow-gauge railroad is more than a train, it is a ride through history. Skagway is also the home of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historic Park, which honors the stamperders of the Klondike by protecting the historic buildings & trails of the Gold Rush era.

Shore Excursion Tips: Take a ride on the White Pass Yukon Railroad/Walk around the historic town

DAY 7 | Glacier Bay National Park

Princess is one of just three cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay, the highlight of your Southbound cruise. Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park & preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margery Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. Not surprisingly, Glacier Bay National Park & its epic ice giants are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising Alaska's magnificent park system. During your scenic cruise, friendly Park Rangers will join the ship to share their knowledge of this amazing place & will be available to help you identify Glacier Bay's abundant wildlife, including humpback whales, sea otters, porpoises, harbor seals, black bears, mountain goats, bald eagles & large colonies of seabirds. Take in the awe-inspiring scenery as you enjoy an unforgettable day of sailing through this dazzling park, where you'll glide along emerald waters & past calving icebergs, and can breathe in the crisp, fresh air to your heart's content. This evening enjoy one more night to dress up a little on this very casual cruise.

Shore Excursion Tips: Best viewing of Glacier Bay would be from the deck of your balcony cabin or Deck 7 as the decks on the top of the ship get a little too crowded. For warmth, the ship has floor to ceiling windows in many of the areas and the front and back of the ship.

DAY 8 | College Fjord

Discovered in the northwest corner of Prince William Sound during an 1899 research expedition, spectacular College Fjord & its glaciers were named after prestigious east coast schools by the college professors who first laid eyes upon their majesty. Stretching for miles, these massive rivers of ice tumble down from mountains & through valleys, dipping into the pristine waters of the fjord. There you'll have a chance to watch the awe-inspiring process of glaciers calving, or dropping enormous pillars of ice into the sea, as they crack & land with a thunderous splash – a once-in-a-lifetime experience not to be missed! College Fjord not only boasts the world's largest collection of tidewater glaciers, but features magnificent snowcapped mountains as far as the eyes can see. In summer, it's not unheard of to catch a glimpse of one of the area's 40-ton humpback whales feeding in the waters of the fjord. A magical wonderland of epic proportions, so breathtaking you won't want to blink! Cruising here is between 6:00 PM & 8:00 PM so you might not want to spend too much time at dinner this evening. Don't forget to pack today as you will be departing the ship (sigh) tomorrow morning. Later this evening, join your fellow travelers in viewing "The Voice Of The Ocean" competition or dancing the night away at Skywalkers Nightclub.

Day 9 | Talkeetna and Denali

This morning your ship will anchor in Whittier, Alaska. Your group will depart after one last breakfast. After picking up your luggage in the terminal, board your private coach. Travel through the amazing Whittier Tunnel & Chugah Park while enjoying views of the rugged countryside of the Kenai Peninsula along the way. Arrive in Wasilla at the Iditarod Headquarters, home of the famous sled dog race. Experience an included sled dog cart ride...complete with sled dogs! A stop will be had for lunch on your own afterwards. You will then depart for the quaint village of Talkeetna where you will spend the night. Enjoy some time downtown Talkeetna to enjoy this quintessentially Alaskan town which the TV show Northern Exposure was based. Talkeetna is the closest viewing point to see Denali/Mt. McKinley. Hopefully, it will be a clear day so you can get a spectacular view! For those who wish to set foot in Denali National Park, you will have an option to fly there and land on a glacier to see the great mountain up close! Then head to your hotel to check-in for the evening with dinner on your own at the hotel restaurant with spectacular views of Denali National Park right in front of you!
